BEOLA ARGENTATA STONE


Beola argentata is part of the Gneiss family of metamorphic rocks, light grey in color and used since ancient times to make tiles and outdoor flooring. Quarried in Italy, the stone is found primarily in the Val d'Ossola area of the Piedmont region. The uniqueness of this stone lies in its color – predominantly grey, streaked with white – and the presence of pyrite, which lends a slightly golden sparkle. The advantages of this stone, in addition to its obvious aesthetic qualities, have to do with its physical features. Beola Argentata (silvery-green Gneiss) is especially resistant to stressors like wear, freezing and other weather conditions. Flexform stone tops undergo a permanent breathable, stain-proofing, oil- and water-repellent treatment that does not alter their natural appearance. Care: stone surfaces are particularly porous. A special sealant/repellent treatment helps protect the stone without, however, making it completely immune to stains caused by improper cleaning or deposits of oily, waxy substances, dietary fats or coffee. Any spills of these substances on the stone must be removed as quickly as possible. Dampen a soft cloth with water, wring it out well and use it for routine cleaning of stone surfaces. Highly concentrated but mild (pH-neutral) or acid-based detergents could damage the stone or leave halos. Under no circumstances should strong products (like acids or lime scale removers) be used. They could irreparably damage the surface of the stone.


