
Flexform upholstery uses only the highest-quality real, full-grain leather, known for its outstanding softness, natural pliability and plumpness. Strictly tanned in Italy, using precise, time-tested methods, the leather is first buffed, similar to sanding, to smooth the surface in preparation for dyeing. Then the leather is aniline-dyed, using a " through-dyeing" process that allows the color to be thoroughly absorbed by the leather, even into its deepest layers. This is definitely not a surface dye that would reveal the underlying color of the natural leather at the slightest scratch. Any lack of uniformity in the surface color is characteristic of natural leather and therefore should be considered one of its virtues, underscoring its natural origin and value. Nubuck, instead, is a full-grain leather that, during the buffing process gains a chamois-like effect that is velvety to the touch and has a lustrous appearance. This is a rather delicate type of leather. Cowhide is also used to make many products. Because this leather is approx. 3 to 4 mm thick and therefore has more body, it is suited to upholstering surfaces with rigid or metal structures. The Flexform collection includes a number of leathers with carefully selected colors and textures that enhance the design and timeless elegance of the company's products.


